TEAM GUIDELINES:

- Each team can consist of a **min of 2 and a max of 3 students**.
- Each team must have **one Team Leader**, who will be the official point of contact with the organizers.
- Every team must register with a **unique team name**.
- Once registered, **team details cannot be modified**.

PROBLEM STATEMENT SELECTION RULES:

- Each team is allowed to have **only one problem statement**.
- Each team can participate in **only one domain**.
- A maximum of **6 teams** will be allowed to work on the same problem statement.
- Problem statements will be allotted **randomly using a pre-defined structured plan**.
- Once a problem statement is allotted, **it cannot be changed**.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

- All team members are expected to follow the institution's **code of conduct** within the venue premises and act responsibly.
- Any form of misconduct, misbehaviour, unethical practices or disruption may lead to **immediate disqualification**.
- Any form of **plagiarism** leads to disqualification.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- The decision of the **judging panel and organizing committee will be final and binding**.
- Organizers reserve **the right** to:
 - Modify rules if necessary
 - Disqualify teams violating guidelines
 - Participants are advised to regularly check official announcements for updates.
- Use of **open-source** libraries & API s is permitted.

HARDWARE GUIDELINES:

- Participants are asked to bring their own specific hardware components for their project.
- Basic components will be available in stalls at the venue. Participants can buy them by paying respective amounts.

ACCOMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Rooms will be provided for refreshments accordingly.
- The essentials for the refreshments will not be provided by the organizers. The participants are asked to bring their own essentials.

FOOD GUIDELINES:

- Tokens will be given to all participating candidates.
- Food will be provided for Day1-Lunch and Dinner & Day2-Breakfast and Lunch.
- Refreshments will be provided accordingly.

TRANSPORT DETAILS:

- Students can avail college transport during Day 1 morning to reach college.
- The bus routes will be communicated 5 days before the event.
